Zach Williams, director of commutations presentation. A native of Ogden. Talking about Dee, built in 1970. It's a big concrete donought suspended with seismic challenges. It was built without any walls- all open. The school has made some tremendous progress- three years ago it was the lowest performing schools in Utah (out of 800) Through hardwork by teachers and principal- it's now up above the 33% mark. The district is encouraged, and has had a replacement for the school. On the property by Liberty Park, plans are to build a school that would hold twice the capacity- 650 students or more- designed to be science/tech/engineering/math magnet school. Made available to students throughout the city. Early childhood, pre-school (YMCA) taking on that challenge- and also adjustment to school will be community center- full size gym- work out facilities- used in the afternoon by afterschool programs and community organization programs. This is the vision for the school- makes possible for the project to qualify—new market tax credits. The community center will be ran by?? Owned by school district, and will be leased to partners who operate. Boys and Girls Club primary partner. The school would have the capability to use the gym. IN conjunction, the city is going to de re-development of Liberty Park. Changing it from older model park to one more integrated. Madison Avenue will be vacated and go to the park. The architects designing the school-exploring different types of learning. All surfaces are writable walls- all dividers are solid but can be reconfigured. Teachers will collaborate and work together. 70 inch flat screen ty's that are fully touchable. Buildings will have points of security into the buildings. Opened up for discussion. Concept of magnet school is curriculum- geared to provide enhance support in curriculum geared towardsscience- tech-engineer-math. 2 year period before the school is ready to go. The community center will help the students that are in the school- the current students are using Boys and Girls Club after school. Community steps into gap and helps carry student through. Tutoring will be happening after school. Will be open to the public in recreation programs-depending on programming, there should be accommodations for general public. Everyone wants to make sure that this isn't another experiment-like Dee. City and district need to partner together. This is considered vital to attracting residents to this area. There is currently no open house to discuss the school. The public would like some input in the design and layout. Are there any plans for James Madison? No. The old school? Thinking it will possibly be housing. This is up to the city on what to do. We should be able to have a lot to say.
